

Instructions to open a new 360° horizon in the program Stellarium

- 1.- Download the attached file to the Desktop. Although it has a .zip extension, do not decompress it.
- 2.- Download the most recent version of the free program Stellarium from www.stellarium.org and run it on your computer.
- 3.- Open Stellarium. On the menu down the left hand side, click on "[Sky and viewing options window \(F4\)](#)" Chose "[Landscape](#)" and at the bottom, in the Options box, chose "[Use associated planet and position](#)".
- 4.- Lower down on the same tab, click on "[Add/remove landscapes...](#)"
- 6.- Next, click on "[Install a new landscape from a ZIP archive...](#)" and look for the zip file on the Desktop. Click on this and open this.
- 7.- Stellarium will say: "[Success - Landscape has been installed successfully](#)" and you will see the background of the program change.
- 8.- Click on the x to close and return to "[Landscape](#)" and check the little box which says "[Use this landscape as default](#)". Close and ENJOY!

Note:

The compressed ".zip" file may now be deleted from the desktop if you like.

The data and horizons which you can use from this program are approximate.
